



## BIBLE VERSES TO READ WHEN YOU'RE FEELING...

**AFRAID:** "When I am afraid, I will trust in Him."

(Psalm 56:3; see also Psalm 118:6; Isaiah 41:10; 2 Timothy 1:7)

**ANGRY:** "Be angry and sin not: let not the sun go down on your wrath." (Eph 4:26; see also Psalm 4:4; Prov 16:32; James 1:20)

**ANXIOUS:** "Cast all your anxiety on Him, because He cares for you." (1 Peter 5:7; see also Philippians 4:6, Matthew 6:34)

**BETRAYED:** "Even if my father & mother abandon me, the LORD will hold me close." (Psalm 27:10; see also Heb 12:3; Num 5:6)

**BITTER:** "Get rid of all bitterness, rage, anger, harsh words, and slander." (Eph 4:31; also Heb 12:15; Acts 8:23; Psalm 71:20)

**BURDENED:** "Come to me, all you who are weary & burdened, & I will give you rest." (Matt 11:28; see also Gal 6:2; Luke 11:46)

**CONFUSED:** "God is not the author of confusion but of peace..." (1 Cor 14:33; see also Psalm 71:1; Isaiah 61:7)

**DEPRESSED:** "The LORD is near to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit." (Psalm 34:18; also Ps 42:11)

**DISCONTENT:** "But godliness with contentment is great gain." (1 Tim 6:6; see also Hebrews 13:5; 1 Tim 6:8; Phil 4:11-13)

**DISCOURAGED:** "Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged. Be strong & courageous." (Joshua 10:25; also Joshua 1:9; Phil 4:13)

**DISRESPECTED:** "So do not be surprised, brothers, if the world hates you." (1 John 3:13; & John 15:18; 1 Pet 2:23; 2 Tim 2:15)

**DOUBTFUL:** "...stop doubting and believe."

(John 20:27; see also 2 Cor 4:8; Matthew 21:21; James 1:6)

**ENVIOUS:** "A heart at peace gives life to the body, but envy rots the bones." (Prov 14:30; see also James 3:6; 1 Pet 2:1; Job 5:2)

**HATEFUL:** "Whoever says, 'I love God,' but hates his brother is a liar." (1 John 4:20; also Prov 10:12; Matt 5:43-44; Lev 19:17-18)

**HOPELESS:** "My soul, wait in silence for God only, for my hope is from Him." (Psalm 62:5; also Heb 10:23; Rom 15:13; Jer 29:11)

**IMPATIENT:** "...help the weak, be patient with everyone."

(1 Thess 5:14; see also Colossians 3:12; 1 Corinthians 13:4)

**INFERIOR:** "But God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise..." (1 Cor 1:27; also James 2:5; 1 Tim 4:12)

**LAZY:** "Laziness brings on deep sleep, and an idle soul will suffer hunger." (Prov 19:5; also Prov 13:4; Prov 6:11; 2 Thess 3:10)

**LONELY:** "The Lord... will be with you. He will never leave you nor forsake you." (Deut 31:8; also Psalm 68:6; Matt 28:20; Gen 2:18)

**MISTREATED:** "Indeed, all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will be persecuted." (2 Tim 3:12; also Matt 5:11-12; 1 Pet 4:14)

**MISUNDERSTOOD:** "Evil men do not understand justice..." (Proverbs 28:5; see also 1 Corinthians 1:18 and 2:14)

**NEEDY:** "God will supply all your needs according to His riches... in Christ Jesus." (Phil 4:19; 2 Cor 9:8; 2 Pet 1:3; Prov 34:10)

**PROUD:** "Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall." (Prov 16:18; see also James 4:6; Luke 14:11; Prov 11:2)

**RESENTFUL:** "Resentment kills a fool, & envy slays the simple." (Job 5:2; see also Phil 2:14-15; Col 3:13; Romans 12:19)

**SICK:** "Heal me, O LORD, & I will be healed; save me, & I will be saved." (Jer 17:14; also James 5:14-16; Psalm 30:2 and 103:3)

**SINFUL:** "Repent... so that your sins may be wiped away." (Acts 3:19; see also 1 John 1:9; Prov 28:13; Rom 6:1-2 and 8:1)

**STUPID:** "Now if any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all." (Jam 1:5; Psa 119:98; John 14:26)

**TEMPTED:** "And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil." (Matthew 6:13; see also 1 Corinthians 10:13; James 1:13)

**UGLY:** "...beauty is fleeting, but a woman who fears the LORD is to be praised." (see also Prov 31:30; 1 Pet 3:3-4; Ecc 3:11)

**UNAPPRECIATED:** "Do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men." (Col 3:23; 2 Tim 4:7-8; Matt 25:21; Rev 22:12)

**UNLOVED:** "I have loved you with an everlasting love..."

(Jer 31:3; see also Psalm 103:17; Rom 5:8; Rom 8:35-39)

**WEARY:** "I will refresh the weary and satisfy the faint."

(Jer 31:25; see also Matt 11:28-30; Isa 40:29-31; Gal 6:9)
